GENERAL INFORMATION

Responsibilities

- To supervise, guide and interact with students on field trips and activities including before departure, during the bus ride, and after returning from activities until picked up by the homestay.
- To manage students' behavior by ensuring they obey rules of the activity venue, listen to instructions, and behave appropriately during the bus rides.
- To encourage positive interactions between all students.
- To ensure students are out of harm's way especially when crossing the road, getting on or off the bus, and during activities by the water.
- To ensure their designated students are accounted for at all times during the activity.
- To lead students to a safe area in case of an emergency and to stay with them until help arrives.

Hours of Work

- Will vary from program to program, activity to activity
- Excursions vary in length, from half day to full day with various start times
- Usually based out of Riverside Centre
